

REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

The Republic Day is a day of national pride. On 26th January 1950, the constitution of India came into force and our country became the Republic. The 69th Republic Day was celebrated in all its solemnity and grandeur at Gita Niketan Awasiya Vidyalaya on 26th January, 2018.
